Course Duration:

Candidates will be assessed both practically and theoretically throughout the duration of this course. All text books to accompany this course are provided.

Progression Routes:

Additional Information:

Candidates are required to attend our purpose built Gas Training and Assessment Centre and undertake all 'off the job' assessments in accordance with the course criteria. Once you have completed the in house training sessions, you will also be required to complete the 'on the job' evidence from your placement. When you have collected sufficient 'on the job' evidence, you will be eligible to undertake the initial ACS CMA1 Once the ACS assessments are successfully completed, you will be able to register with Gas Safe or seek employment with a Gas Safe Registered company as an operative.
