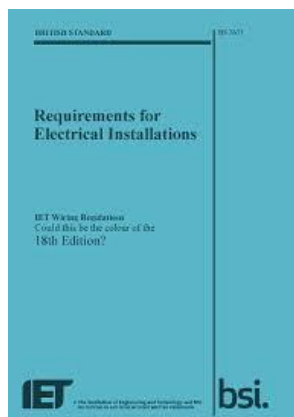

18th Edition Wiring Regs

BS7671:2018

The **NEW** "18th Edition Regs" are now due to be published (and available) on 1st July 2018. It is known that there are significant changes to the regulations, after public consultation in 2017.

All electrical installations must comply with the new BS7671:2018 regulations from the 1st January 2019.

Walsall Training Centre Ltd, anticipate that the training and assessment programme will be available to engineers from August this year. This obviously is subject to the assessment and training criteria being written by our awarding body.

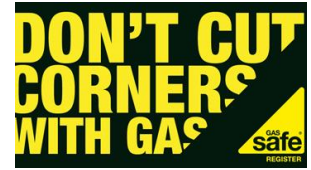
