Who has to comply with the Water regulations?

Owners and occupiers of premises and anyone who installs plumbing systems and/or water fittings have a legal duty to ensure that systems satisfy the Water Regulations.

Advance notice must be given of proposed instalments in most cases so that Architects, Building Developers and Plumbers have to follow the regulations on behalf of future owners or occupiers.
